I take great pleasure in presenting the Annual Report of our College, established by our beloved Founder Hajee Karutha Rowther, which always believes in imparting quality education to the underprivileged sections of the society. This Academic Year 2023-2024 is marked by many events and stories of success. I am delighted to inform you all that the University Grants Commission (UGC) has extended the Autonomous Status to our Institution for a period of 10 Years, until 2034. This can be attributed to the dedication and team spirit of the Management, Staff and Students. On behalf of the staff and students of Hajee Karutha Rowther Howdia College, I take immense pleasure in welcoming everyone to the 68th Annual Day of our College being celebrated today, the 7th of March 2024.

Strength and Courses

The tremendous development of our College is measured by the growing strength of the students and the number of programmes offered every year. Our College is proud of the overwhelming strength of its students this year, which is 2588 of whom 1430 are women. In the Aided Stream, our college offers Undergraduate Programmes in Economics, English, History, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Computer Science and Commerce. At the Postgraduate level, we have History and Commerce Programmes. Under the Self-Finance

Scheme, in addition to the Undergraduate Programmes in Arabic, Tamil, Business Administration, B.Com. (Banking), Commerce with Computer Application, Biochemistry, Microbiology and Information Technology, we have Postgraduate Programmes in Mathematics, Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Zoology, Economics, English, Tamil and Commerce with Computer Application, as well as M.Phil. Programmes in Commerce, English, Chemistry, Mathematics and History. The Departments of Commerce, Physics, English, History and Zoology are recognized Research Centres of Madurai Kamaraj University. Non-affiliated Value-Added Courses have been conducted by the Departments of Commerce, Business Administration, Computer Science and Biochemistry in this academic year.

I would like to thank the College Management for their generous donation of Rs. 8,00,000/- towards the development of our College. The College is an IGNOU Study Centre that provides Certificate Programmes in subjects like Arabic Language, Tourism Studies, Environmental Studies and Beekeeping. The College operates 12 buses exclusively for the safe conveyance of women students.

The Department of School Education, Tamil Nadu, felicitated the family of our College Founder with the award **ngw;NwhHfisf; nfhz;lhlNthk; tpUJ** for having donated the land worth Rs. 15 crore to construct the Government Model Higher Secondary School, Uthamapalyam. Our College received **Environment Sustainability Award** from the District Collector of Theni during the Independence Day Celebrations 2023. The **Ayya K. Nammalvar Award** was also bestowed upon our Institution by Nansei Arakkattalai for Green Initiatives and Environment Conservation. Around 24 Functional MoUs have been signed with different Institutions, Professional Bodies and NGOs for the sustenance of quality education, promotion of research and to foster industry - academia collaboration.

The **NAAC Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR)** for the year 2022-2023 was submitted successfully by the IQAC on 26th February 2024. In association with the Department of Horticulture and Plantation Crops, Government of Tamil Nadu, the IQAC also organized the **Bamboo Tree Plantation Programme**. Two awards - **Luminary Alumni Award**, for honouring the prominent alumni who have excelled in various fields and contributed profusely to the society, as well as **Exemplary Student Award** – in recognition of the budding talents of our students who have brought laurels through performance beyond the curricula, have been initiated by the IQAC from this academic year. The Departments of our College have organized a number of events in collaboration with IQAC, including Workshops, National/International Seminars and Awareness Campaigns.

The Alumni Association of our College organized the Alumni Meet on 26th August 2023. More than 720 Alumni participated in the meeting.

A Five-day Student Induction & Orientation Programme – “Deeksharambh” was conducted for the First Year Undergraduates from 22nd to 28th June 2023. Almost 800 Freshers from seventeen Departments were the beneficiaries of the Student Induction Programme.

82 LED projectors have been installed in every Classroom and Seminar Hall to support ICT - enabled teaching, which has the power to completely change the structure and methodology of the teaching and learning process.

In keeping with our Institution's eco-friendly practices, a Digital Display Board has been put in place on campus to facilitate effective communication with staff, students, and employees about the ongoing events of our College.

E-Service, a student self-service portal, has been instituted on the College campus for the students to avail Public Internet Service Domain.

The Club encourages the budding talent of the students by providing an artistic environment for expressing themselves freely.

A **Rangoli Competition** was conducted for the students on 29th August 2023 on the eve of Onam. Similarly, a **Seminar** was also organized by the Club on 15th September 2023 to mark Kalaingar Centenary Celebrations. **Guest Lectures** such as **“Kalaingarum Maanila Suya Aatchiyum”** by **Prof. Duraisamy, Former Head, Department of History, Hajee Karutha Rowther Howdia College**, and **“Kalaingarum Ramanujarum”** by **Dr. Ragavan, PG Assistant**

in Tamil, S.U.M Higher Secondary School, Royappanpatti, were arranged for the students. The Club and Andril Ilakkiya Suttram jointly organized a **District Level Literary Competition** on 14th October 2023 in which Oratorical, Essay Writing, Verse Writing and Quiz Competitions were conducted.

Internal Complaints Committee

Dr. S. Hasan Banu, Associate Professor, Department of Commerce, is the Presiding Officer of the Internal Complaints Committee.

In the Student Induction Programme conducted on 26th June 2023, **Ms. H. Habeeb Rani, Assistant Professor, Department of Mathematics, & Member, ICC**, sensitized the students on the purpose of the constitution of the Internal Complaints Committee in the Institution. The students were also informed about the procedures involved in lodging complaints against physical and sexual harassment. Moreover, ICC has also attempted to apprise the students by displaying the draft of the **Indian Penal Code (IPC) for Sexual Offences** along with a Toll – Free Number and Committed Phone Numbers in the premises of our Institution.

Women’s Forum

The Women’s Forum of our institution takes steps to provide ample opportunities to the women students for participating in social as well as cultural activities. Dr. M. Fathima Parveen, Associate Professor, Department of Physics, is the Coordinator of the Forum.

During the Student Induction Programme an **Orientation Programme** was organized for the I year UG women students on 27th June 2023. With a view to promoting awareness about the role of women in environmental conservation and celebrating **Women’s Equality Day**, an **Awareness Rally** was organized on 29th August 2023. Around 500 women students participated in the rally and saplings were distributed to the local community. In association with the Evidence Organization, Madurai, our Forum conducted a **Seminar “Women in Political Leadership”** on 19th September 2023, in which **Mr. Kathir, Director, Evidence Organization**, discussed women’s contribution in protecting the political and human rights.

Commemorating **World Food Day**, a **Grand Food Festival** was organized on the theme “**Water is Life, Water is Food, Leave no one behind**” on 5th October 2023, in which traditional and delicious food items were displayed in the stalls for sale. In accordance with **International Year of Millets 2023**, the Forum organized a **Culinary Competition** on 20th December 2023, to

highlight the multiple nutritional benefits of millets and to increase the consumption of millets. The women students highlighted their culinary skills by preparing delicious millet recipes.

Deeniyyath Education

Deeniyyath classes are offered for the Muslim students in after hours on every Wednesday to revive and sustain the Islamic spirit in them. In an attempt to encourage the Muslim students attend Deeniyyath classes regularly, examination is conducted at the end of every academic year for the I and II year students and prizes are distributed to them based on their performance.

In accordance with Milad – un - Nabi celebrations, competitions such as Oratorical, Qirath, Essay Writing and Quiz were conducted for the students and prizes were distributed to the winners.

Youth Welfare Wing

The Youth Welfare of the Institution creates opportunities to the youth to identify and exhibit their talents. Dr. R. Career Counselling/ Training & Placement Cell

The Cell takes efforts to serve the students by motivating and guiding them to seek placement in reputed companies. This year almost 279 final year students have got placements in several companies.

On 7th August 2023, the students of the Department of Business Administration and Commerce with Computer Application attended a **Webinar “APPLY4MBA”**. Five of our students were selected in the **Off Campus Interview “Job Fair for Multiple Positions”** on 19th August 2023. Similarly students also attended an **Online Interview “Rinex Technologies – Campus Recruitment Drive”** on 29th August 2023.

Around 152 students of our institution were selected by Venpa Group of Companies, Chennai, through the **Campus Recruitment Drive** on 10th January 2024. A **“Career Exhibition and Workshop”** was organized by the Cell on 23rd January 2024 to raise awareness about the diverse opportunities available besides affirming the significance of Employability Skills in students. The **Resource Persons Dr. T.K. Thirumalaisamy, Associate Professor & Head, Department of Physics, Mr. A. Muthukumar, PG Assistant in Tamil, Government Higher Secondary School, Uthamapalayam**, and **Mr. B. Ajmal Khan, Educator, Eju Panasia, Theni**, addressed the students. The Placement Cell has proposed to conduct a **Workshop “English Speaking Skills: A Requisite for Job Placement”** for the final year UG and PG students in the month of April 2024. **Two On Campus Drives** will be conducted on 04th April 2024 and 05th

April 2024 by Gainup Industries India Pvt. Ltd., Dindugul, as well as Aquasub Engineering, Coimbatore, respectively.

Guidance for Competitive Examinations

The Guidance for Competitive Examinations Cell provides relevant academic and career information through guidance sessions for higher studies as well as for identifying suitable careers. Dr. T. Anas Babu, Assistant Professor, Department of History, is the Coordinator of the Guidance for Competitive Examinations Cell. Intensive coaching is offered to SC/ ST/ Minorities/ OBC candidates who aspire to attend competitive examinations.

With a view to creating awareness about Teachers' Recruitment Board, Tamil Nadu, in the subject of Mathematics and providing tips to crack Competitive Examinations, an "**Orientation Programme for Mathematics Students**" was organized on 29th September 2023. Our **Alumnus Mr. A. Sheik Mohamed, PG Assistant in Mathematics, Government Higher Secondary School, Alagagoundanpatti, Tiruchirappalli**, acted as the **Resource Person**. Fifty students of the Department of Mathematics comprising III UG, I & II PG were the beneficiaries of the Programme.

Similarly, an "**Outreach Programme for GATE - JAM Examinations 2024**" was organized by the Cell in coordination with Indian Institute of Technology, Madras, on 4th October 2023.
